When is testing required?

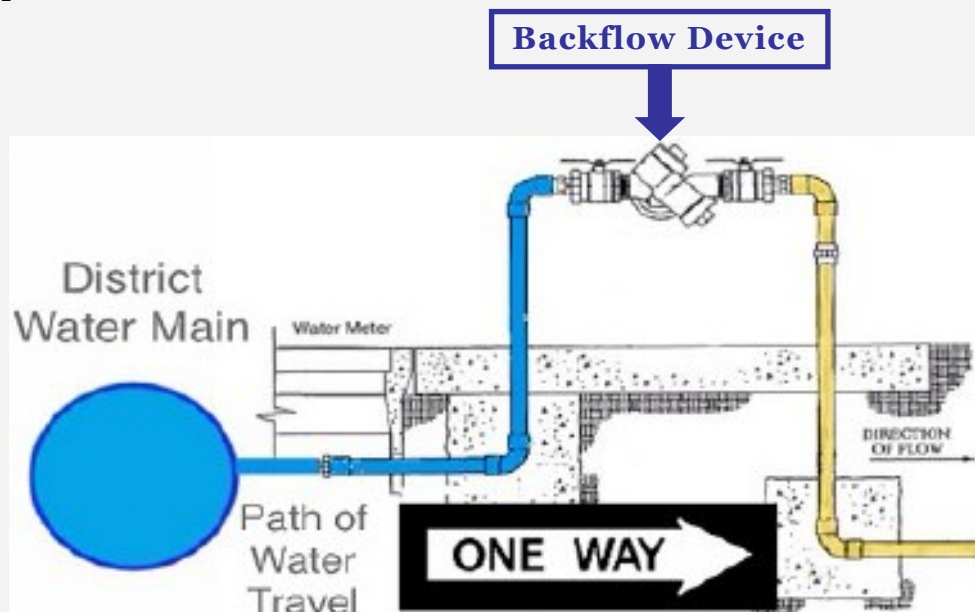
- Help us help you! Please turn in backflow testing results to Foresthill by June 28th, 2024. This ensures staff will be able to prepare and submit the reports to meet the State of California requirement on your behalf.

Why do I have to test my backflow device?

- State regulations require that backflow devices be tested annually. A backflow prevention device protects the public water system by preventing contamination.

Do I have a backflow device?

- The State of California requires most commercial businesses and some residences to install a backflow prevention device. If you have any questions, call Foresthill and we will help you through the process.

Delinquent Accounts



Water service accounts that are over due should be paid in full as soon as possible. Foresthill has prepared an informational letter letting owners know of the past due amount and the potential to transfer the amount to the property tax roll. Placer County allows the District to submit delinquent utility bills to the County for placement on the annual tax rolls and collected with property taxes. This places the burden of payment for water usage on the property owner who used the water, rather than forcing all other rate payers to carry their share of the cost.

Fire Hydrant Accident



One of Foresthill's fire hydrants was involved in a hit and run accident March 31, 2024. Foresthill's operators quickly repaired the hydrant to protect the community's critical water supply. To keep our community's water supply safe please report any fire hydrant damage to Foresthill.
