Sugar Pine Dam and Reservoir



In November 2003, the Sugar Pine Dam, water rights, transmission system, regulating reservoir, and water treatment plant were purchased by the Foresthill Public Utility District. The Foresthill community was actively involved in numerous town meetings during the purchase process. Despite interest from another agency, Foresthill successfully secured the deal. By taking over the dam, the district avoided paying another agency for water, as it had done for many years in the past. Foresthill has been able to save money due to the purchase over twenty years ago. This move could be seen as an insurance policy to ensure that the community has control over its water supply, rather than relying on an external agency.

Mill Creek



Mill Creek is Foresthill's secondary and/or seasonal water source. This source provides a small but consistent flow of water during winter and spring. Mill Creek is only a seasonal source because it typically dries up in the mid-late summer months. Staff does routine maintenance around the Mill Creek Dam including brush clearing, cleaning, and making minor repairs to extend the life of the structure.
