The repair of the leak was complete in 2.5 hours. No services were affected and no interruption to the water service was needed. A temporary road patch has been placed. The Best Time to Water



- Watering in cooler temperatures will reduce monthly water consumption charges.
- It's a great step to improve water efficiency in landscape irrigation if you irrigate your yard early or late at night.
- Using drip irrigation and/or a smart controller can prevent overwatering.
- To ensure that your yard gets the most out of its watering, it's best to avoid watering during the middle of the day. This allows the water to soak into the soil and be absorbed by the plants before it evaporates.
